What is ArtSmart?

ArtSmart classes are specifically designed to help children learn about the broad, exciting history of art. Classes are tailored with age appropriate lesson plans. All supplies are included and brought into the classroom by the teaching artist.

For example, for a lesson on the 'well-known' artist Michelangelo class would begin with a study about the artist. What mediums he used and why and about his most remembered works. The class would then review his works and learn how to differentiate it from other artists work. Then, the final activity is having the children create their own masterpiece on a paper that is attached to the underside of their desks. This simulates the 'experience' of painting the Sistine Chapel.
